1. We had so far about 8 collaboration meetings, but (in my personal opinion) this one was the most spectacular:

- a) We could see that PARIS project achieved the promised in the MoU goal: the phoswich and cluster of 9 phoswiches concept works; and moreover - 4 clusters are operational and are working as expected;
- b) There was 2 years delay, but because of that we have 2 types of equivalent detectors;
- c) In the PSC meeting it was decided to extend the MoU until 2020 and going for 8-9 clusters; and with two new partners: JINR Dubna and NUSTAR@GSI/FAIR
- d) Many tests were performed (Orsay, Strasbourg, Milano, Krakow, Warsaw, Mumbai, Rosendorf, Debrecen, ...) and were reported here;
- e) Most important - first real experiments were performed (IPN Orsay, GANIL, CCB Krakow) – the preliminary results look very exciting;
- f) We learned about the exciting opportunities for new experimental venues: LNL/SPES Legnaro, TIFR Mumbai, HIL Warsaw, JINR Dubna, GSI/FAIR,...
- g) ... and about the possibility for coupling PARIS to other detectors: NEDA, GASPARD, (FAZIA), TAS, DEGAS, ...

2. The future of the PARIS project looks quite bright, although there is still many things are to be done.
